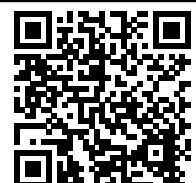
Mahogany brass-bound writing box bearing the label "Bought from William Dobson" and bearing his trade label under both lids. With a baized writing slope, each half lifting up to reveal compartments underneath. Original gilded brass candle sconces. Fitted and compartments for an ink bottle, nibs and pens etc, one with a secret sprung drawer. One long drawer in the base; the lid can be supported on a ratchet with the original detachable reading bar. William Dobson is recorded at 166 Strand, London, from 1805 to 1825. The original lock, stamped 'GR', indicates the reign of George IV, 1820 to 1830. Defra self declaration certificate (for the ivory): 9BDPCP42 John Beazor Antiques is a family firm, established in 1875 and based in Cambridge since 1940. We are a traditional antiques shop, but very much in the 21st century. We deal in 18th and early 19th century furniture, barometers and clocks.
