An arched painted dial with spaniels to the corners and a lady in a country scene to the arch. A seconds dials with brass hands and date aperture. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Circa 1845. John Pape of Blyth in Nortumberland is recorded in Loomes 'Watch and Clockmakers of The World' book as working from 1827 - 1858.
