This is a stunning Victorian Bristol green glass and silver 'Binocular' or 'Opera Glass' double-ended scent bottle. These type of scent bottles are few and far between and this is a particularly nice example. The faceted tapered green glass body hinges at the centre. The inner compartments at the centre retaining the original gilding. One end is mounted with a hinged lid and the other has a screw top lid. The hinged lid opening to reveal the original clear glass stopper. The screw top lid lined with cork. Hallmarks: Unmarked, which was often the case with silver scent bottle lids but tested as silver. Dimensions: Length: 13cm - 5.1 inches. Diameter: 3cm - 1.2 inch. Condition: Glass in good condition. A few minor flea bites/ nicks to the spines. Inside of neck in excellent condition. No cracks.
