The sleeve sewn in panels and with two orange silk squares with complimentary embroidered motifs. . The colours still vibrant and the silk in excellent condition, protected in a later glazed gilt frame – please note the fabric has not been examined out of frame. . Cranes are considered in Chinese culture one of the most auspicious of birds second only to the phoenix. They represent longevity, happiness and marriage. . . Dimensions of the frame are: . 34.5 inches high and 15.5 inches wide. . For metric please multiply by 2.5
