Made from solid wood, probably cherry wood, moulded and panelled construction with visible pegged joints complete with brass hinges to each side. To the middle of the doors is a pair of stunning original brass escutcheons, and also an original lock (no key). The doors have lovely panelling and mouldings and have a beautiful rich patina. These doors would add character to any home – they could be used as window shutters, doors for a cabinet or for a fitted cupboard.
