Losses, old worm and damages but solid and with a superb natural colour and rich patination. Ecclesiastic in form and possibly part of a church pulpit. . Rare and exceptionally beautiful works of art carved at the beginning of the reign of Elizabeth I and just five years after the death of Henry VIII. . .
