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## Description

A super quality cased English solid sterling silver fork and spoon set. The fork is hallmarked for Sheffield 1926 and the spoon 1929 with the maker's marks being Thomas Bradbury & Sons Ltd and Frank Finley Clarkson. They have been superbly made being a replicas of the Manners Fork of 1632, the earliest English hallmarked fork and a Puritan spoon of a similar date. They are in super condition being free from dings splits distortions and repairs, the case is also great. The fork measures approx. 6.75 inches (17.6cm) long by almost 0.25 inch (1.3cm) wide and the spoon 7 inches (17.8cm) by 2 inches (5.1cm) wide and they have a combined weight of 82 grams excluding the case. A very well designed rare set.
