Description

Gents 9ct gold Garrard wrist watch, 1958. The watch has a 17-jewel hand-winding movement, identified as being by Schild, which is working nicely. The watch measures 31mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the lugs so, although originally designed as a man's watch, it would suit a slimmer wrist. The case is 9 carat gold and there are hallmarks inside the case back for Birmingham 1958 with a case maker's mark for Aaron Dennison, a Birmingham based case maker. The case is in good condition, just light surface marks but nothing too serious. The case back is free from inscriptions. The lens is in lovely condition. The dial is signed with the name of the original retailer, Garrard. It has its original hands, a subsidiary seconds dial and outer minute markers. There is light marking to the dial but not too detrimental. Garrards was founded in 1735 by George Wickes. They designed, manufactured and retailed luxury jewellery, silver and watches. The company is still trading today and as well as having their headquarters in Mayfair, London, they also have a presence in Harrods, London, Geneva, Lebanon, Qatar, Dubai, Moscow and Hong Kong.
