Montagu Barstow was an artist and book illustrator and husband to Baroness Orczy, creator of *The Scarlet Pimpernel*. Montagu was the illustrator to many of her novels and also co-wrote the stage play *'The Scarlet Pimpernel'*, which opened in London's West End in 1903 and ran for over 4 years. Postage/packing and insurance to UK destinations could be organised for no more than £20.
