Description

A superb quality early 20th century walnut dining suite in the manner of 'Waring & Gillow', the winding mechanism stamped 'JOSEPH FITTER, PATENT, BRITANNIA WORKS, CHEAPSIDE, BIRMINGHAM'. This suite consists of a superb quality extending wind out dining table with three leaves, ten chairs in the George I style (eight singles, two armchairs) and a side server/table, although not stamped by a maker, there is no doubt this originated from a company making fine quality items, such as 'Waring & Gillow'. The solid walnut extending table having a finely figured veneered walnut top, veneered on solid walnut leading down to a finely carved edge with a moulding below, a burr walnut frieze and further moulding with three removable leaves, the table having a winding mechanism stamped 'JOSEPH FITTER, PATENT, BRITANNIA WORKS, CHEAPSIDE, BIRMINGHAM' – the removable leaves and winding mechanism allowing the table to be set up in varying sizes making this suite extremely versatile. The table is supported by four finely carved cabriole legs with lion masks to the top and foliate decoration terminating with hairy paw feet. Joseph Fitter (born 1842), a Birmingham machinist applied for a ...
