The blue glass liner fits snugly within the body and the overall quality and condition of this plain mustard pot is excellent. It would be ideal to use and would make a desirable addition to a collection. The silver spoon has been later added but fits the mustard pot perfectly well. Height: 7 cms (2.8") Length: 10.5 cms (4.1") Diameter of base: 7 cms (2.8") Weight (without the liner): 5.7 troy ounces (177 grams) It was hallmarked in London for 1921 by Harry Freeman and remains in excellent condition.
