Description

There were two agreements signed by Napoleon in the town of Tilsit in July 1807, in the aftermath of his victory at Friedland. The first was signed on 7 July, between Emperor Alexander I of Russia and Napoleon I of France. The gilt bronze relief under depicts Napoleon at the Battle of Friedland. Very well cast. Signed on the dial "Rolletfy of Paris". Circa 1830. 8 day movement with outside countwheel striking on a bell, the hours and on the half hours. Measurements: 48cm high x 35cm wide x 13cm depth.
