The Case The clock is in solid brass and stands 24cm high and 15cm wide with a depth of 8cm it is in perfect condition standing on a solid Mahogany wooden base, it is very heavy with thick heavy plates, a top quality old clock. The Dial The dial is in good original condition silvered and black Roman numerals, the clock also retains its original black spade hands. The Movement The movement is an eight-day time only, the movement has been fully restored new spring was added and then serviced so keeping a great time over the eight days via the original pendulum. Overall a beautiful English skeleton clock, that looks stunning on display and contains all of its original features this is quite a rare find these days.
