With overcast cast and spots of blue coming through in patches in the sky. The second horse who has a brown colour coat is called "Industry" who is facing left and in full stride jumping over a fence with a small stream below in mid flight about to land on the rivers bank edge. With a white and black horse in the distance and 3 other white horses further over looking in the opposite direction. Beautiful landscape view with some tall trees in the distance on either flank...
