Excellent cast and superb detail some of which is highlighted subtly with enamel. Signed in the bronze Monginot. The figure stands on a polished, shaped marble base on a small brass plinth. French c 1910. Charlotte Monginot (French, 1872 ~ 1962) Born in Paris, Monginot Charlotte was the daughter of the renowned French painter and engraver Charles Monginot (1825-1900), known for his portraits. She was a student of Denys Puech (1854-1942). Charlotte Monginot exhibited at the Salon de Paris from 1895 where she was noticed by gaining an honorable mention. She made works in plaster or marble and participated in numerous exhibitions in Paris whilst also painting. Many works of Charlotte Monginot were cast in bronze or bronze and ivory. She resigned from the French Society of Artists in 1948. Approximate height 38cm including the base Excellent original condition
