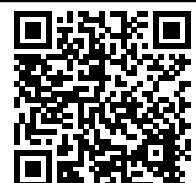
Description

A late 19th century oak extendable dining table with heavily carved grotesque central pedestal. Starting as a 105cms diameter circular table, the table pull-out on telescopic runners to 153cms long by 105 wide, and further to 201cms long by 105 wide. When extended, two pairs of legs which are normally stored between the runners, hinge down and lock into place to support the two additional leaves. The top and leaves have a carved gadrooned edge and the four splay, profusely carved base has grotesque, fire emitting dragon's heads carved to the knees above paw feet. Perfect to use as a circular centre table which can be easily extended for occasional dining.
