Signed to the rocks just below the birds to her left.. Standing on a marble-effect octagonal wooden base. Condition: Excellent, with good light brown colour. Height 18 inches (45.8cm) Weight: 7.8 kgs Date: 1901-1905 Auguste Moreau (1834-1917) was a French Sculptor, born in Paris. His brother was the famous sculptor Mathurin Moreau; His father (sculptor/painter) Jean Baptiste Moreau. Auguste was educated at the renowned Beaux-Arts-de-Paris and was a prolific sculptor himself, specifically of young women. In 1861 he made his debut at the Paris Salon, where he exhibited regularly until 1914.
