EUGENE BATAILLE (1817 - 1880) A beautiful signed and dated 1863 oil on board by Eugene Bataille depicting figures in the village of Vardes which is to the east of Rouen. The work is signed, titled and dated lower right and beautifully painted. He was a pupil of Leon Cogniet and his work is held in numerous museums. Principally remembered as a portrait artist in the classical mould, who was nevertheless given to a touch of romanticism in his scenes of ladies in crinolines.
