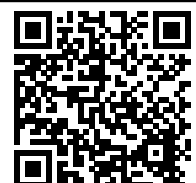
Description

Morgan Dennis (1892 –1960) was an American illustrator and author known primarily for his paintings of dogs. He was born in Boston, Massachusetts and grew up in Long Island, New York. He studied art with William Harry Warren Bicknell. He was commissioned by the Black and White Scotch Whiskey Company to illustrate the "Black and White Scotties", a successful ad campaign used over many years. One of his murals, "The Dog House", is in the bar and lounge of the Sheraton Russell Hotel in New York. "Heather Reveller" is a charming original etching of a Scottish Terrier. Measuring 9"x 7" it is signed in pencil lower right and is mounted giving an overall size of 13" x 11". It is unframed.
