A most unusual example of a miniature chest of drawers / dresser, highly decorative with the intricate parquetry inlay to the top. It is also nice that the highly decorative burl Walnut continues from the front around to the sides. These miniature examples, are often either apprentice pieces where the junior carpenters could practice their skills on a smaller scale rather than using large quantities of expensive timbers, veneers and inlay on full size pieces or furniture. They were also created as salesman samples. There are five drawers to the front, perfect to be used as a jewelry box amongst other things if you wished to put this piece to work. Each drawer has a turned wooden pull and the bottom three having faux escutcheons matching the drawer trim. The box has been professionally re-French polished to gleam and showcase it's true beauty. Excellent all round condition with an old "crease" to the back where it once had knock, stable but mentioned for accuracy. 10 3 /4" tall including it's four turned feet with the top measuring 9 3/4" x 6 1/4".
