The chest has a gonzalo alves cross banded top with decorative ormolu surround, with a central pannel featuring a ribbon tied floral bouquet, over three drawers with floral marquetry decoration and ormolu rococo style handles. The sides are decorated with cornucopia and foliage and raised on angular swept legs with a serpentine apron and ormolu sabots. A lot of intricate detailing has gone into the creation of this chest.
