This shaped rectangular tray has cut off corners with a decorative pierced fretwork gallery and shaped handles to each side. Active at Pelican Works with the trade mark 'PELICAN SILVER'. In 1840 the firm was active at High Street, Sheffield advertising as "By Special Appointment to Her Majesty". In 1932 the grandsons Arthur William and Francis Isaac sold the business to A.L. Davenport Ltd. Francis Isaac Wilkinson founded in 1934 F.I. Wilkinson & Sons Ltd. The firm used the trade mark PELICAN SILVER
