Makers/Silversmiths: One set of makers marks is clear 'C&C'... Albert Cohen & Charles Soloman, or Cohen & Charles, who's firm was established in 1890 at 11 Thavies Inn, Holborn, London. They traded at this address until they sold the business to S.J. Rose & Sons Ltd in 1958. Dimensions: Width: 5.5 inches. Depth: 4 inches (max). Height (handle up): 4.5 inches (14 x 10.1 x 11.5 cms)
