An original framed and glazed landscape watercolour painting of Darlington taken from the surrounding countryside. Painted by John Dobbin (1815-1888). It depicts a large church in the background (St Cuthbert's, where he was baptised and later in life completed several commissions), with trees and a female (possibly his wife) walking in a long dress along a hedgerow in the foreground. Condition: Good colour, with little signs of fading. Recent frame with UV glass. Unsigned. Date: 1874 Dimensions: Width: 23 inches (59 cm) x Height: 18.75 inches (48 cm) The Artist: John Dobbin (baptised 21 March 1815 St Cuthbert's, Darlington, - 1888 London) was an English landscape painter, the son of John and Elizabeth who lived in Weaver's Yard. John, the son, did not follow the same trade as his father, who was a weaver working in Pease's Mill in Darlington town centre, but was apprenticed instead to a cabinet-maker in Grange Road. He was not happy with this choice of career and in his twenties left for London to become an artist. Dobbin frequently returned to his home town, and Darlington features in many of his works. His paintings became more spiritual after the death of his fi...
