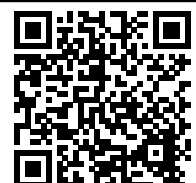
A complete 'chanteh' - vanity-bag - made by a Qashqa'i nomad circa 1900-1920. The face is woven in fine soumak technique incorporating a large '5' in the centre, symbolising protection and thus protecting the contents of the bag which might have included jewellery, coins and mirrors. The back of the bag is woven in plain-weave technique. Size: 30cm x 26cm (12" x 10").
