Gorgeous and unusual Grand Tour bronze inkwell resting on a circular marble base. The body of the inkwell has a tripod base with taurine legs and large bulls heads in a trio. Aloft the finial of the lid is a Young Bacchus feeding a goat a punnet of grapes. Very fine work, notice the details in the hair and the eyes of the bull heads. The casting and finishing are very fine and indicative of 19th century Italian craftsmanship. Dated to c. 1850. The patina and quality are indicative of the age. Excellent antique condition, chip on the marble base, patina on the bronze commensurate with age. Please carefully regard all photos. 18 cm in height 981 g Shipping is included in the price.
