Minton's porcelain was known for its high quality and was used by some of the most famous names in the pottery and porcelain world. Minton's porcelain was also used by some of the most famous painters of the time, including J. M. W. Turner and John Constable. Minton's porcelain was so highly regarded that it was used by royalty, including Queen Victoria and Prince Albert. In fact, Queen Victoria once said that Minton's porcelain was "the finest in the world." Today, Minton's porcelain is still considered to be some of the best in the world.
