It has been stylishly made having a engine turned designed to both the front and back and blue and green enamelled stripes along with the Royal Corps of Signals badge. It is in very good condition being free from dings splits and repairs. The enamel is free from chips and cracks, a tiny scratch near the emblem. It measures approx. 3.5 inches (8.8cm) long by 2.75 inches (6.8cm) wide and weighs 92 grams. A superbly designed piece.
