18th century worcester This jug was manufactured between 1770-1785 It is most unusual as it is only approx 14cm tall. And "The parrot pecking fruit-second version" I SC usually on either taller jugs OR plain thrown and turned shapes. This jug has the worcester mask spout and moulded and incised body. It has clearly the hatched crescent to the baseplate. So whilst the pattern is not necessarily as rare as version one , the combination here is rather more unique. As it is a small jug , press moulded with cabbage leaf and mask. This jug was been in private family home for the majority of its existence and has never before been offered to the open market. No chips, cracks hairlines or Frits Just some signs of under glaze firing grit on the body towards the handle. In exceptional condition.
