The body is square in shape, with cut shoulders and multi point stars cut to the sides and base. The pull off lid has a rope twist border and exquisite floral piercing, with engraved detail. The lovely items were used for sprinkling chalk or sand over ink, to prevent smudging after a letter or document had been written. They are always highly sought after and a Georgian example, is a lovely find. Dimensions below.
