A fine small 'Bachelor' tea pot on associated stand. Bearing no makers marks, but both pieces are made of Old Sheffield Plate and dating to c1780. The tea pot has lovely faint etched decoration to the body with a turned wooden handle and finial. The stand has a similar style etched decoration (but not identical to the teapot) and stands on four elegant feet. The condition is very good overall with no dents or splits. There is faint copper bleed to the raised edges of the tea pot. The interior is reasonably clean with a couple of stubborn dark marks. The stand has slight copper bleed to the etching. Overall, a very elegant and delicate piece. Total weight approx 458g. Total height approx 14cm. Tea pot - Height approx 12cm. Span approx 23.5cm. Base measures approx 11cm x 7.5cm. Stand measures approx 18cm x 12.5cm. Height approx 3cm.
