A fine quality Edwardian period inlaid mahogany revolving Bookcase by Maple and Co. of London. The top having a moulded edge with inlaid stringing in boxwood and ivorine. To the centre there is an inlaid panel depicting 4 stylised inlaid fish and boxwood foliate scrolls with the same outline stringing. The frieze below the top having chequer inlays. The shelves are supported by slats with inlaid stringing and secured in place with brass studs. The plinth base, with stringing, sitting on cross platform with iron bracket supports and terminating in original brass and ceramic castors. Sympathetically repolished in our workshops and now offered for sale in excellent condition, ready to go straight into the home. Dimensions: Width and Depth 50cms Height 87cms Maple & Co was established by John Maple, a shopkeeper from Horley, Surrey, who later opened a furniture shop in Tottenham Court Road. However it was his son, John Blundell Maple, who made Maples & Co a success. With exceptional business skills, John B. Maple took over the company while still a young man. By the 1880s they were the largest furniture store in the world, exported their fine furniture to every continent. ...
