A quality double fusee mechanism striking the hours on a gong of 8-day duration. The original pendulum transportation lock and winding key. Circa 1890 William Palmer of Bristol is recorded in A J Moores' 'The Clockmakers of Bristol' book as working in All Saints Lane from 1856-1896.
