Description

An extremely rare Georgian silver 'Lemon' label or bottle ticket. This wonderful piece is rectangular in shape, with a reeded border and squared corners. 'W Ketchup' is engraved to the centre. The label is supported on a belcher chain and the title is in 'pricked' initials. In Georgian and early Victorian times, large silver cruet sets contained many bottles of various condiments and flavourings. Each had a name ticket hung around the neck and the quality examples were in silver. Before the more famous and enduring tomato ketchup was introduced in the early 1800's, ketchups came in a number of other flavours, such a mushroom or walnut. Both of these eventually gave way to the unassailability of the more popular successor. An unusual collector's piece, with a practical use. Dimensions below.
