A very handsome solid and usable early chair made by hand in c.1640 . . Dimensions are: . 20 inches wide, 18 inches deep and 41 inches high. . 17.5 inches from floor to seat and the back is 24 inches high from the seat. . For metric please multiply by 2.5
