There is a hanging hole now fashioned on the back so that it can be hung, but it would work just as well as a bookend, or a stand to display candles etc. There are square cut chequered panels alongside the winding tendrils of plants, the front featuring a central almost fleur-de-lis design with a central boss and two curved buds.
