A painted dial with blued steel hands signed 'Wright London' with a cast brass bezel surround. Circa 1845. There are a few clockmakers with the name 'Wright' recorded in Loomes' 'Watchmakers and Clockmakers of the World' book as working in the 18th and 19th centuries. This example dates to circa 1845.
