William IV mahogany Gothic-topped bracket clock by H Yeomans, Nottingham. A very fine bracket clock in a mahogany case inlaid with brass and with caryatid corners and Grecian finials; 8 day hour striking movement, repeat mechanism, strike-silent, calendar and, unusually a seconds dial; with its fine original bracket. An important clock of some presence and fine quality. Circa 1835 Henry Yeomans is recorded as working 1828 to 1864 16" (40cm) wide, 9" (23cm) deep and 29 ½" (75.5cm) high John Beazor Antiques is a family firm, established in 1875 and based in Cambridge since 1940.
