Description

This remarkable and very finely turned delicate white marble charger was made in India and dates to the late 19th century. It has the thinnest cross section thickness that I have ever seen in similar examples that I have owned previously and similarly, the extremely fine inlaid decoration forms a continuous floral design which radiates from a central flower head and trails out intricately forming many flower heads and stems all finely cut and inlaid into the white marble in bright semi-precious stones which include agate, lapis lazuli, turquoise, malachite, mother of pearl amongst others which are all remarkably fine in their detail.
