Description

This is a beautiful example of a late Victorian French carriage clock manufactured around 1870 for the English market. The 8-day movement is spring driven, striking the hour and the half-hour on a spiral gong. The maker designed this clock to have a repeating function, so by pressing the button on top of the case, the clock will repeat the hour strike, allowing the user to know the time in the dark. The case is beautifully decorated around the sides with a delicate filigree pattern of bronze retaining the original patina. The dial is made out of enamel, hand decorated with blue numerals, and surrounded by a gilded brass mask. The clock comes with a winding key. Ref.3753
