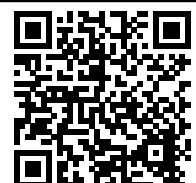
Description

The scroll handle follows this theme and to the front there is a vacant cartouche. The hinged lid is extensively engraved repeating the decoration of the body and has a vacant cartouche to the middle. The thumb grip is shaped and engraved with flowers. The pot is fitted with a wonderful cranberry glass liner and comes with an associated silver spoon. A wonderful collector's item, both usable and decorative. Dimensions below.
