This handsome chest of drawers with oblong shaped well figured top, ebony and boxwood strung and crossbanded border, with moulded edge. Over brushing slide with cockbeaded edge, and pair of brass pull handles. Bank of four, well figured, full width drawers, all graduated in height, with cockbeaded edges, double swan neck brass handles with batwing back plates, matching brass escutcheons and locks. All flanked by fluted canted corners, with larks tongue chamfer. Raised on bracket feet. Oak drawer linings, and solid mahogany frame. A particularly handsome, high quality chest of drawers, in very good condition. Very serviceable and ready to use. Dimensions: This chest of drawers measures approximately 84 cm (33") tall, 88 cm (34.5") wide, and 49 cm (19") deep.
