Description

A superb example of a rosewood table cabinet dating from the early 19th century. It is a pagoda shape with beautiful mother of pearl inlaid decoration. It has wooden ring carrying handles and stands on gadrooned bun shaped feet. It comes with a working key which locks the doors. The lid lifts to reveal a mirror below, mounted in a red leather tooled border. The mirror folds forwards to reveal a document holder behind. The top section of the cabinet has been fitted with dividers and lined in blue silk. The doors of the cabinet open onto a series of drawers, each inlaid with mother of pearl. The top two are lined in the same way as the top of the box, making useful storage for trinkets or jewellery. The bottom drawer contains a writing slope with both of its original inkwells and a gilt tooled leather writing surface that matches the border around the mirror. The writing surface does fold out to give a larger surface and also lifts up for extra storage. The whole piece is in excellent condition and although it has been used it has been well looked after over the years. The silk linings have been renewed and the interior is clean and tidy. There are a few small knocks and ...
