After Hendrick MOMMERS (1623-1693) Haarlem Vegetable Market c1750 An early copy c1750, of an entertaining Dutch vegetable market scene in an Italianate landscape. The original was painted by Hendrick Mommers, a renowned Dutch Golden Age landscape painter. Painted in oil onto an oak panel and presented in a later frame. Biography According to Houbraken, Mommers was a Haarlem painter of vegetable market scenes, who was the first teacher of the young painter Dirk Maas Mommers became a member of the Haarlem Guild of Saint Luke in 1647, where he was last registered in 1665 when he appears to have moved to Amsterdam. Condition In common with many paintings on early oak panels, it has split at some stage and then been repaired. The frame has minor repairs is 19th century and has been adapted to fit.
