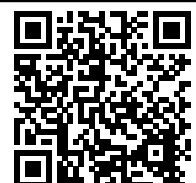

The baluster glass body very finely sliced-cut, the front and back panes decorated in criss cross patterns. The hinged silver lid engraved with initials and the date 1848..
