Note: Gunmetal is different from Brass as it has a higher copper content which gives it a slightly "pinkish" colour compared to the gold colour of Brass. Proportions vary but 88% copper, 8-10% tin, and 2-4% zinc is an approximation. Originally used chiefly for making guns and ordnance. This was later replaced for weapons with steel. The composition of brass is generally 66% copper and 34% zinc.
