Cast brass bezel with convex glass forming the door, and matching convex painted dial set behind with Roman numerals and the makers name (William Payne working in London: reference - <https://www.britishmuseum.org/collection/term/BLOG76232>). Fine quality original blued steel hands. Double fusee movement with anchor escapement and bell striking on a rack, on the hour. Fully serviced and working.
