A George II period mahogany, oval top, gateleg drop leaf dining table, Circa 1750. With solid mahogany top, with twin drop leaves, each supported by a gateleg, hinged from the well figured elm frieze. Raised on fine tapering turned legs on attractive carved ball and claw feet. A charming table, well presented, though with some flaws. Sturdy and ready for use. Dimensions: This table measures approximately 70 cm (27.5") tall, 162.5 cm (64") wide leaves up, and 50 cm (19.5") wide leaves down, 125.5 cm (49.5") deep. Condition: Please see the pictures for details of the items condition. - This table is in reasonable condition, commensurate with its age, and is structurally sound and sturdy. Some marks and blemishes. The top has small partial split on the top which has been sympathetically repaired. Repair to the top of one leg and bottom of another. Well presented. Cleaned and wax polished. Ready for use. - As with all vintage & antique furniture there will be signs of use, marks, wear & tear, etc.

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
