This is a fine quality antique border counties Georgian oak dresser base / sideboard, displaying a stunning mellow colour, circa 1760, in excellent original condition. Believed to originate from the border counties between England and Wales, drawing on design influences from Montgomeryshire, mid Wales, notably the ogee shaped frieze. The style and colour of this oak dresser were indicative to this area due to its more moderate terrain, rich in mineral content. The Georgian oak dresser base is constructed with a two-plank top, with three drawers below. The drawer fronts are cock-beaded to add variation, incorporating the original drawer linings, cons...
