Description

Frederick Richard LEE, RA (b.1798-d.1879): A framed oil painting on board of a Devon woodland scene. There are notes verso which read "Scene in Devonshire by F R Lee RA presented by the artist to Captain Henry Heywood Wilson in 1873. Note: One of the main points in this picture is that, viewed in certain lights, one can see the stream extending a long way back under the deepest shadows cast by the trees". About the artist: Frederick Richard LEE, RA was a prolific Landscape, Seascape and Still-Life painter. He lived mostly in Barnstaple, Devon. Exhibited at the Royal Academy between 1824-70. He often collaborated with Thomas Sydney Cooper and Landseer. Died in S. Africa 1879. Dimensions: Height: 18 inches (46cm) x Width: 22 inches (56cm) Date: c.1872-1873
